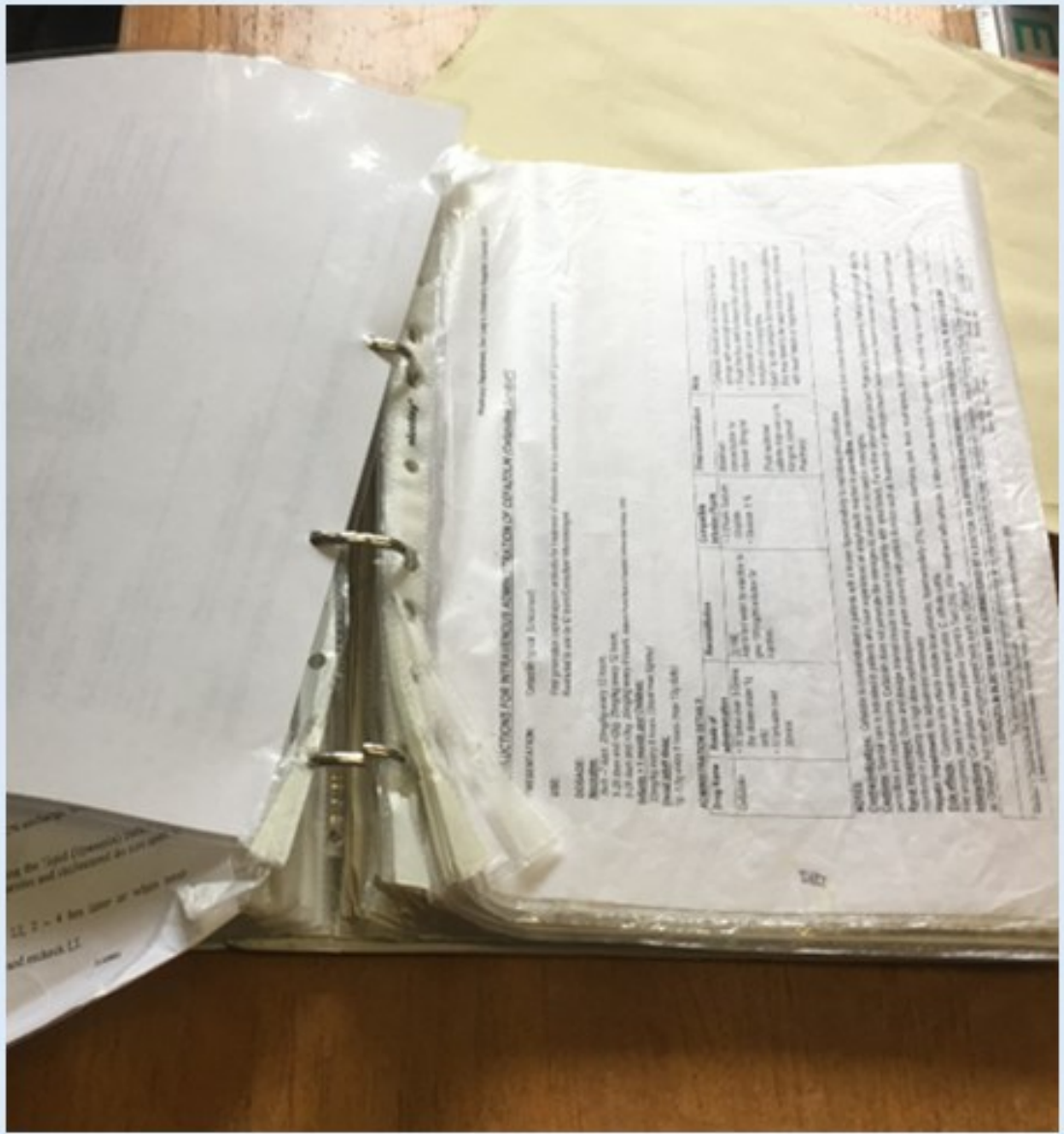

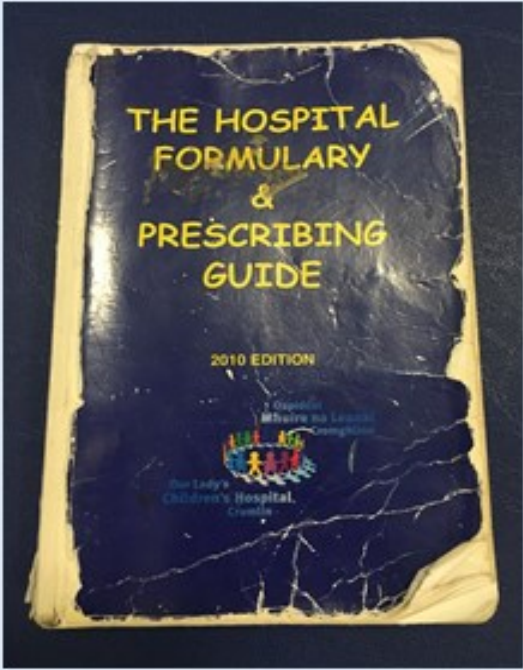

100%

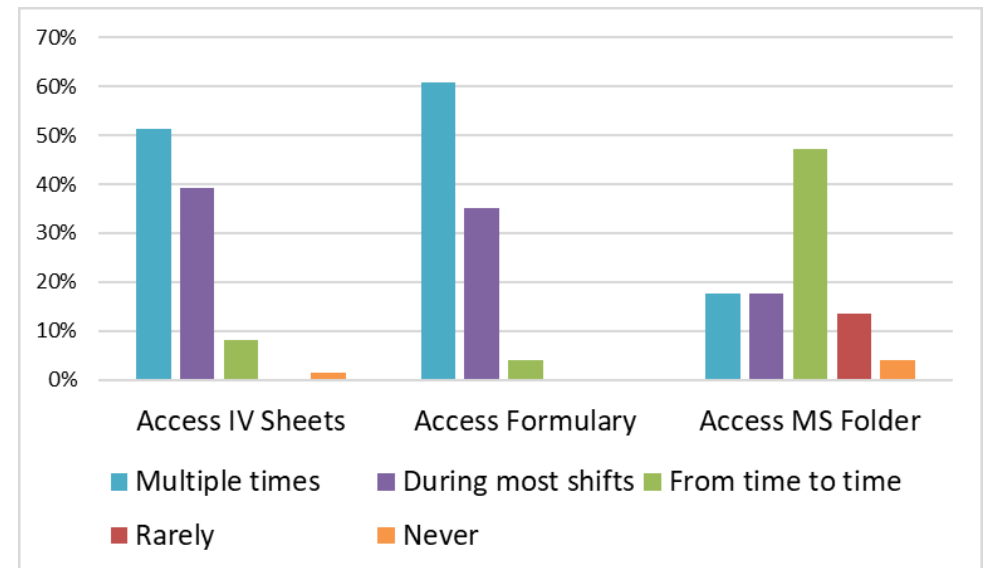
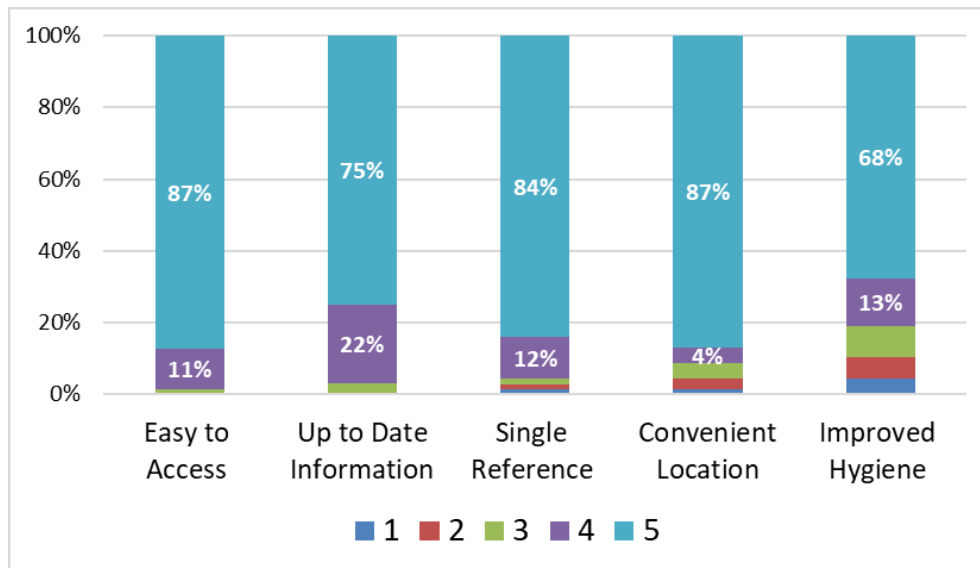

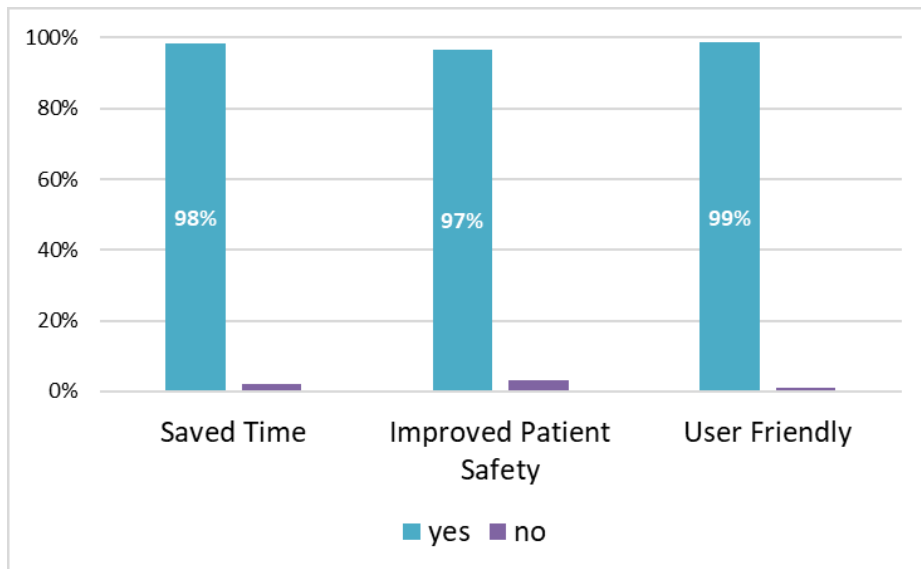
On a scale of 1 (not beneficial) to 5 (highly beneficial) please rate the following features of the tablets:
